Dear Supporters,

In 2016, FIGS provided payment for prescription medicine and medical supplies to 5,500 uninsured and under-insured Wake County residents. We believe that when people receive their acute and chronic medications in a timely fashion, they don't have to rely on hospitals' emergency departments for their healthcare lowering healthcare costs for all.

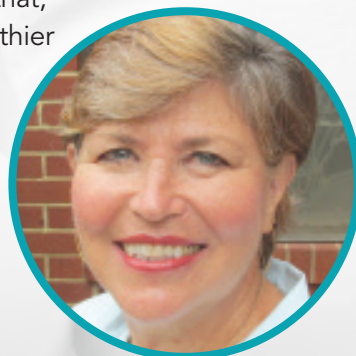
Collaboration with fellow service providers here in Wake County is always a priority. The Urban Ministry Crisis Support Center and the Open Door Clinic and pharmacy within Urban Ministry interview our clients and if qualified, these patients receive their medication from our pharmacy network at no cost to the patient. FIGS reimburses the agencies for the cost of the prescriptions.

In 2016, we revised our prescription voucher system at our partner agencies to streamline the process and make access to medications more convenient. We added the Alliance Medical Ministry to our group of service providers to increase our outreach in February.

Of course, none of what we do would be possible without the continued support of those who contribute to our important mission. We keep our administrative costs low so that we can donate 95% of the funds received to purchasing needed medication.

That is the heart of what you help us do, and for that, we are supremely grateful. Wake County is a healthier place to live because of your generosity.

**COLLABORATION:** Building an effective health care support system cannot be achieved alone. We strive to be a role model through our willingness to share information and resources.

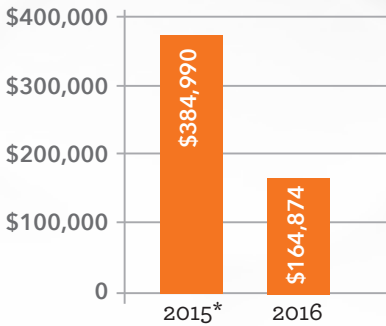

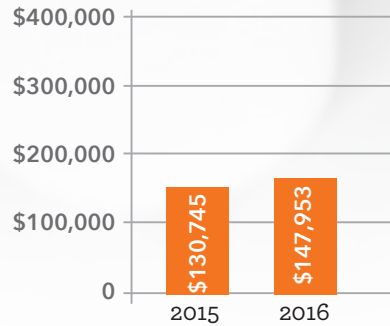
